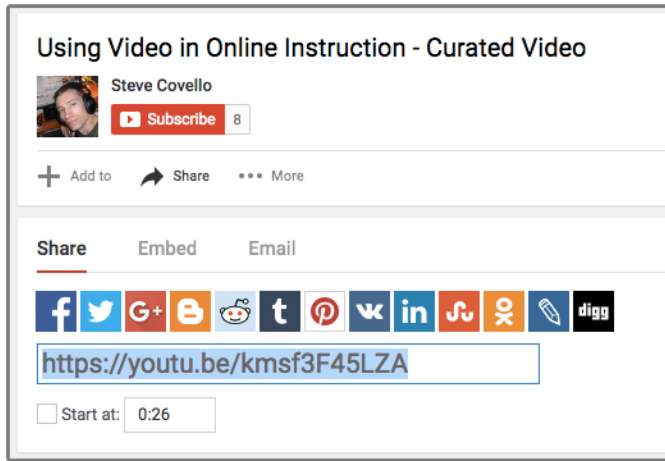


How to a YouTube video for students to review

Step 1: Copy the YouTube share URL

Look in the Share settings for your YouTube video.
Copy the Share URL.



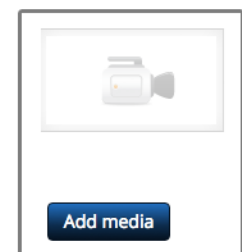
Step 2: In your Moodle course, add a Kaltura Video Resource

In Edit mode, click on the "Add an activity or resource" link.
Select the Kaltura Video Resource button under the Resources section.



Step 3: Name your video resource and Add Media

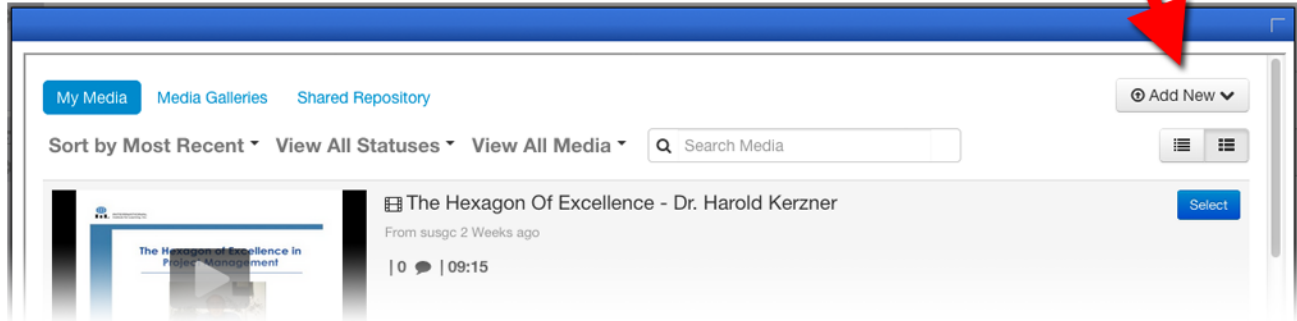
Name your video resource.
In the Video section, click on the "Add Media" button,

Step 4: Click the "Add New" button on the upper right corner

A pop-up panel will appear. Click on the "Add New" button


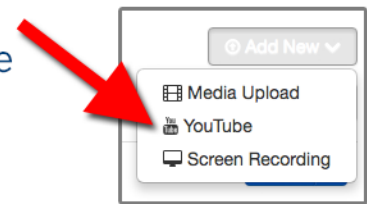


Step 5: Select YouTube

Select the "YouTube" option from the Add New options.

Paste the YouTube share URL into the box.

Click the Preview button. It may take a minute for all of the video information to load.

Step 6: Preview your media

Review and edit the information extracted from the YouTube video. Click Save, then click "Back to Browse and Embed".

Step 7: Select your video

Click the Select button to embed your video into Moodle.

Step 8: Scroll down and save the page
