



## Online Hybrid & Online Blended Class Sessions: Student Checklist

### Overview

Online Hybrid (OH) and Online Blended (OB) classes provides select instruction and activities in real time using GSC-approved online meeting technology (Zoom). This allows faculty and students to collaborate live via the Internet from their own computer or appropriate mobile device. Additional activities and assignments are completed outside of live virtual meetings and shared within Moodle (GSC's learning management system) as outlined in the course syllabus.

### Student Checklist

Prior to registering for a virtual synchronous (Online Hybrid or Online Blended) class, students are asked to verify that they have reviewed, understand, and agree to the expectations and limitations as described below:

- I understand the description of virtual synchronous classes as listed above
- I have regular access to a [high-speed Internet connection](#)
- I have reviewed and meet the [technical requirements](#)
- I will have the appropriate technology to participate in these sessions before the first session, including an appropriate computer or mobile device, microphone, speaker, and web camera (webcam) to fully participate
- I have successfully [tested a Zoom session](#)
- I understand that I am expected to attend all Zoom class sessions; classes will be recorded and may be shared with other students in the class
- I understand that it is my responsibility to have the appropriate technology to attend virtual sessions. In the event of technical issues with Zoom, I will let my instructor know and [contact Zoom support](#) to troubleshoot issues
- I understand that technology issues beyond the College's control (such as weather-related power outages) will require classes to be rescheduled
- I will review the [Technical Requirements & Best Practices](#) site in advance of my first session, and I will log in 15 minutes before the start of my first session to allow me time to contact Zoom support for technical issues
