

Downloading Software with Microsoft Azure

Note: All software available via Microsoft Azure for Students is only compatible with Windows 7, 8.1, and 10.

Microsoft DreamSpark / Imagine has been replaced with Microsoft Azure for Education.

To access Azure:

- Go to:
 - <https://azureforeducation.microsoft.com/devtools>
- Click Sign in (blue button)
- If prompted for an account, enter your @go.granite.edu email address
- This will direct you to Granite State College login page, re-enter your username and password.
- You will then receive a page where you need to certify your agreement to Azure's terms. Click "yes" and you will be informed you are accepted as a registered student. Click "next."
- You should see this screen:

- Click the View Key button to retrieve your product key and **write down that key – you will need it later during the installation process! This is very important!**
- Click the download button to begin downloading the installer software (note: the files are very large (usually 3.5-4GB) and this download can take a long time (more than 30 minutes))
 - Firefox:
 - A green down arrow near the top right corner of your browser
 - Click on the arrow to view your downloads
 - Click on the file to run it
 - Chrome:
 - A button will appear at the bottom of the browser
 - Make a note of the file name and location of your downloaded file.
 - When the download is finished, proceed with the installation guidance below.
 - Internet Explorer / Chrome
 - Will generally download into your downloads folder or will prompt you to identify a folder. Make a note of the file name and location.
- Installing the Software
 - When the download is complete, access the file you just using the following steps. The file downloaded is a disk image, so the file extension is .iso.
 - Windows 7 users:
 - If you cannot open the ISO or burn it to a DVD-R, you will need to download and install Microsoft's virtual CD-ROM which will allow you to open ISO files as a virtual disc drive. You can find this software at <https://www.microsoft.com/en-us/download/details.aspx?id=38780>
 - Windows 8.1 and 10 users:
 - When you double-click on the ISO file it will mount the file as a virtual CD-ROM drive and open the contents in file explorer.
 - Access the disc and run Setup.exe in the root directory:

- If you get a 32-bit or 64-bit error, click on the Office folder and double click on the appropriate file:

 Setup32.exe	9/9/2018 08:29	Application	5,050 KB
 Setup64.exe	9/9/2018 07:01	Application	7,468 KB

- Setup32.exe will most likely be for Windows 7 systems
- Setup64.exe will most likely be for Windows 10 systems

- If one gives you, the 64/32-bit error (not compatible with 32/64-bit operating systems or office products) use the other installer.
- The installer should run automatically (no options to select).
- When the installation is complete (or during the installation), you will be asked for the product key.
